Call for LCDP Officers in 2025!

Elections for the 2025 La Crosse County Democratic Party Officers and Board are fast approaching!

Please consider joining us as we work in 2022 to ensure Democratic victories in this crucial election year. If you have any questions, or would like to be considered, contact any of the members of the Nominating Committee.

2025 Officers:

All officer and executive board positions will be up for election. These include four Officer positions: Chair, Vice-Chair, Treasurer, and Secretary; as well as five At-Large Executive Board members.

There will be several open seats. Many on the board have served multiple terms and would like to take a break!

The 2025 Nominating Committee: Anyone interested in running for the 2025 Board should contact any member of the Nominating Committee.

The Process:

September 3 - October 21: Anyone

interested in serving on the 2025 Board should contact one of the members of this year's nominating committee. The committee will verify that you meet the qualifications for office and are interested in being on the ballot.

Monday, October 21: At the October LCDP Regular meeting, the Nominating Committee will present the names of all people interested in running for LCDP office to the full membership. The membership is also able to nominate members from the floor at this time. No nominations will be considered after the meeting is adjourned.

Monday, November 18: At the November LCDP Regular meeting, all nominees will be given three minutes to speak to the membership about their reasons for joining the 2025 Board. These speeches will be followed by a vote using the Ranked Choice Election model. The Secretary will announce the results at the November meeting, as soon as the votes have been tabulated.
