Voter Turnout in La Crosse County is Vital! Take a Friend to the Polls!



Nominations are now open for La Crosse County Democratic Party Executive Board positions. Those positions include; Chair, Co-chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and 5 At Large members. Qualifications include being a member in good standing of the LCDP for a period of three consecutive months prior to the election.

As a member you can nominate yourself or member/s as long as they have agreed to serve in that position. If you would like to nominate yourself or another person please email the nomination committee at nominationcommitee@ laxdems.com and include the first and last name of the person you're nominating and the reason why you're nominating them. You can also nominate by speaking directly to the individuals on the nominating committee which include; Carla Pena, Terry Benson and Christine White. You can also nominate yourself at the regular October meeting on Monday, October 21st at which the Slate of Nominees will be presented and later voted on at the November meeting on November 18th.

Monday, October 21: At the October LCDP Regular meeting, the Nominating Committee will present the names of all people interested in running for LCDP office to the full membership. The membership is also able to nominate members from the floor at this time. No nominations will be considered after the meeting is adjourned.

Monday, November 18: At the November LCDP Regular meeting, all nominees will be given three minutes to speak to the membership about their reasons for joining the 2025 Board. These speeches will be followed by a vote using the Ranked Choice Election model. The Secretary will announce the results at the November meeting, as soon as the votes have been tabulated.


